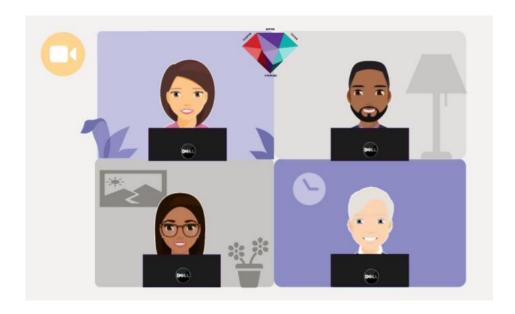

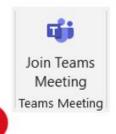

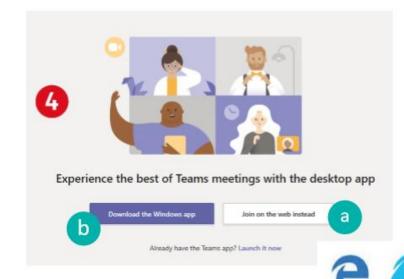

- 1) Click the icon OR link that says Join Microsoft Teams Meeting. (also icon 3)
- 2) If dialling in via telephone there will be a phone number shared with you. (In some instances this function will not be available)
- 3) As per above.
- 4) When selecting the links to join the meeting your device, will ask how you would like to join the meeting.

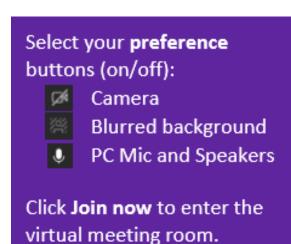

- 1) Attendees' names will be visible in the participants tab.
 Please consider this if entering your full name prior to joining the meeting.
- 2) Use the chat function and react to others' written comments using the emoji options. A facilitator will be monitoring the chat.
- 3) Raise your virtual hand as you may not always be on screen for the host to see, they will be notified that your waiting to speak
- 4) Using this icon will show additional options such as turning on live captions and adjusting your sound settings.
