Further work to façade at Hindon Court – Wednesday 12 April

Dear Resident,

We're writing to let you know that following the completion of work at your building we'll be returning to seal the bricks where the scaffold ties were placed in order to secure the scaffolding. These were found not to be sealed to the required standard, so this is necessary in order to rectify this issue.

The work will only take a few hours and is scheduled to take place on **Wednesday 12 April** immediately following the Easter Bank Holiday. We'll be using abseilers, but this will only affect those apartments which face onto Wilton Road as listed below.

- Level 2 F1
- Level 3 F14
- Level 4 F16
- Level 5 F26
- Level 6 F28
- Level 7 F30
- Level 8 F35

A summary of this letter
Additional work to seal
brickwork on your building
will take place on 12 April.

This will be the last bit of work on the cladding project.

We are still chasing EWS1 forms.

Abseilers may pass your window so please bear this in mind if you're in your apartment during this work. This will conclude all the work required at Hindon Court regarding the cladding. We apologise for any inconvenience, and we thank you for all your patience and understanding during the project.

We're chasing a copy of the EWS1 and we hope to be in receipt of this soon as we are advised that it is being peer reviewed by the chartered fire engineer. We will write to you further once we have received confirmation advising this has been loaded on to Network Homes website and also the FIA Portal.
