EWS1 form now available – no external wall remediation required

I am really pleased to be able to confirm that our fire engineer has now issued an EWS1 form (EWS – external wall system) for your buildings. Following the investigations that took place last year, this certificate confirms that your building has been rated as ‘A1 – there are no attachments whose construction includes significant quantities of combustibile materials’.

We carried out our own due diligence on the information we have received from the fire engineer and are happy with the rating received and justification given.

We hope this provides you with peace of mind that no remedial fire safety work is required to the external wall system.
