Dear residents.

Case Management Hearing

On 22 April, we had a case management hearing regarding our application to the First Tier Tribunal for a remediation order and the remediation works taking place at Tabriz Court and Shams Court.

In submissions for and during this hearing, we received information regarding the work from the contractor Hycgan and the freeholder HEB Assets. The main points are below: **Shams Court**

- Fifteen per cent of materials have been removed from Shams rear elevation, with new cladding material installation to begin later this month.
- They estimate that Shams' external wall remediation will be complete within the next six months.
- Further defects have been discovered within the external wall while the remediation work is taking place – we've not been told what these further defects are and are requesting further details. We don't believe there is any additional cause for concern as the fire strategy for the building remains the same, but will of course update you if our position changes following receipt of further information.

Tabriz Court

- They are still waiting for building control approval for the work at Tabriz (as previously advised, because Tabriz is a 'higher-risk building' it is subject to a different approval regime to Shams).
- There is no update on timelines for when work at Tabriz will begin.

Please note, all of the above information has been received from the contractor or freeholder, therefore we cannot confirm the accuracy of things like expected completion dates.

Next steps

The tribunal has stated that there will be another case management hearing in September 2024. The tribunal has stated that they expect the freeholder to take 'reasonable efforts' to keep us updated on progress of the works.
