## Awaiting fire engineer's report on new external wall investigation

We last wrote to you that we would be carrying out an investigation to your external wall system, under new PAS9980 guidance. This is following a previous investigation we carried out that identified a potential risk.

We're now waiting for our fire engineer to issue the resulting report to us, which will determine the way forward and what the next steps are. We'll be communicating with the original contractor once we have the findings of this report, so they can engage with us on the next steps.
