Further investigations to take place on Monday 16 December

We are planning to return on **Monday 16 December** to carry out further intrusive surveys into your building's external wall system. This is so the original contractor Hill can inspect the issues we have previously found; they will be covering the costs for these surveys, which will inform their scope of remedial works.

Additionally, this will include investigations into the 5th-floor glazed panels, which we were unable to access during the original survey.

We'll make sure we put things back the way we found them before the team leave on Monday.
